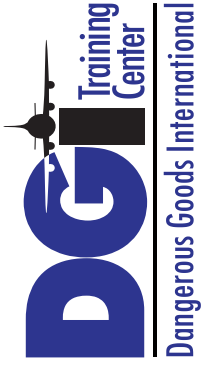

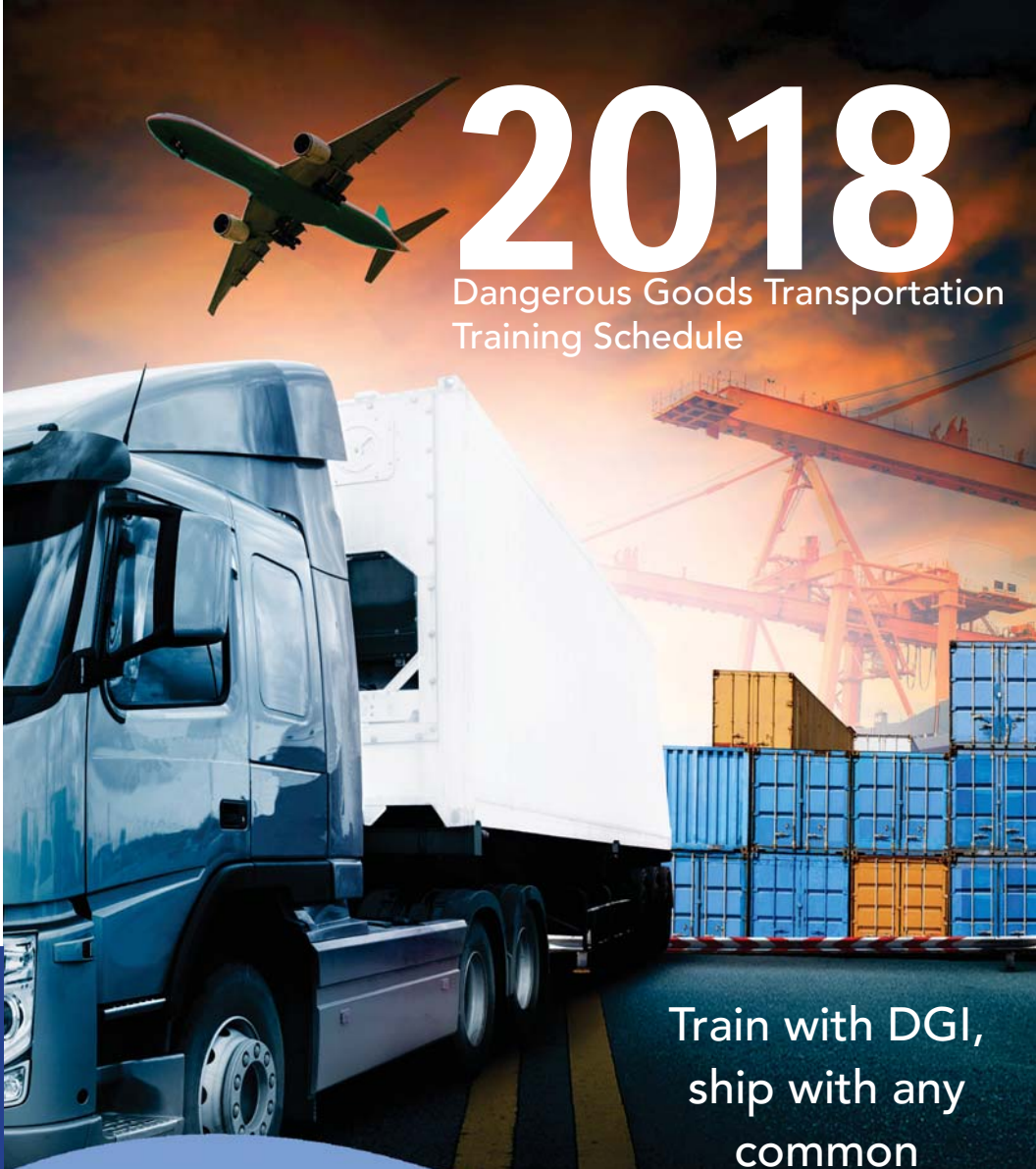

Training - It's required by law!

If you ship dangerous goods to, from or within the USA, employers and employees must adhere to the training requirements under 49CFR, Subpart H, Section 172.700.

Serious penalties are imposed if you are not properly trained. Hazmat employees are required to have initial training and then maintain recurrent training as required by mode of transport.

- 49CFR - Highway and Rail Transport - Every 3 years
- 14CFR - Airline Personnel - Every 24 months
- IATA/ICAO - Air Transport - Every 24 months
- IMDG - Ocean Transport - Every 3 years
