

For Forwarders and Cargo Agents seeking IATA Agent Status Only

CNS Requirements and DGI Training Center

CNS requires 2 staff from headquarters and 1 person from each station to have current DG training from an IATA Endorsed franchise school. In addition, those staff must have Acceptance level training which is not required by ICAO, IATA or 49 CFR for cargo agents or freight forwarders. CNS is simply an organization and can make their own rules, which you must follow if you wish to be a member.

All other staff may continue to be trained by DGI as you normally would, and we thank you for your continued support.

CNS 2.1.F, DG Training (excerpt)

F) TRAINING REQUIREMENTS

DG TRAINING

- 1) Applicant shall have at least two employees at the head office who have completed current training for Dangerous Goods Acceptance.*
- 2) Applicant shall have at least one employee at the branch office who has completed current training for Dangerous Goods Acceptance.*
- 3) Training for Dangerous Goods should be in accordance with the IATA DG Regulations.*
- 4) Training is to be administered by either an IATA accredited training school, an IATA member airline, or in-house training delivered by an internal staff member of the Applicant who holds a current DG Category 6 certification and IATA instructor certification.*
